#### What is a Virtual Gala?

#### How do I participate?

I would like to purchase the dinner option with my ticket, do I live in the delivery radius? Dinner delivery is available within 30 miles of downtown Chicago. The registration deadline for meal delivery ticket options is Wednesday, March 10<sup>th</sup>.

#### When will my dinner be delivered?
